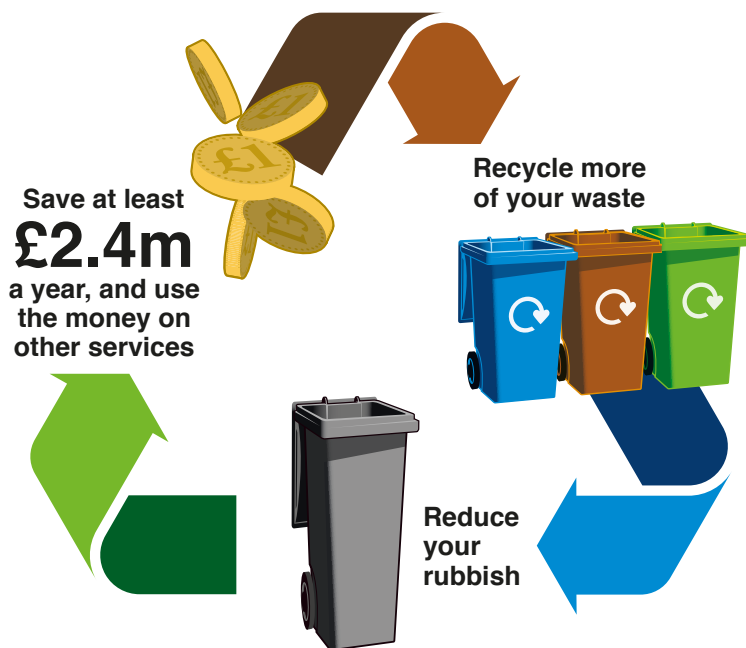



BIN CHANGE.

What will happen to my old bin?

All the old bins will be recycled.

Bin tagging and labelling.

Your new bin will be tagged and have an address label which will help us to identify
and return lost or stolen bins in the future.

Bin calendar.

There are no changes to how often or when we collect any of your bins.


What if my neighbours put out extra rubbish?

Don't worry, we'll be monitoring collections and supporting anyone with extra rubbish –
if this help is ignored they could face a fine.

Paper and card-based material ONLY.

Polystyrene

What can go in your **BROWN** bin:



Pop bottles

Washing-up liquid

Bleach

Shampoo

Mouthwash

Suntan lotion

Milk bottles

Food tins

Drinks cans

Aerosols

Nail varnish remover

Foil pie dishes

Foil trays

Tin foil

Glass bottles and jars

Plastic bottles ONLY – we cannot recycle other sorts of plastic.

Plastic film

Bottle tops

Plastic toys

Yoghurt pots

Plastic food trays

Plastic bags

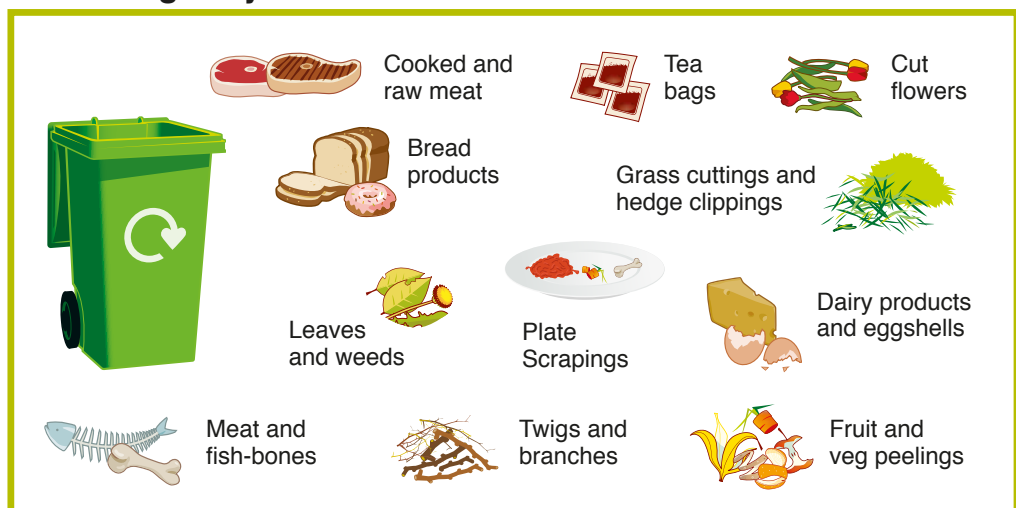


How to use your GREEN bin:
