S4B's aim is to make a positive difference in Brunswick. As such, we have developed a Neighbourhood Plan which sets out our service commitments to you over the next twelve months.

In developing the plan we sought customer feedback, particularly through our most recent S4B satisfaction survey, and sourced information from government and national databases to help identify the key issues affecting Brunswick and Ardwick.



BRUNSWICK

Brunswick is a neighbourhood on the edge of Manchester city centre famously known as the birthplace of Prime Minister David Lloyd George, who led the Government between 1916 and 1922.

The area boasts a strong sense of community and is a short walk from the vibrant city centre and several university campus's including The University of Manchester to the West. It also features The Apollo Manchester, formerly known as the Apollo Theatre, which is a famous concert venue and Grade II listed building.

Brunswick has great transport links, including proximity to interCity routes, the Manchester Metrolink System, and Europe's busiest bus route.

The Brunswick estate was originally built by Manchester City Council in the late 1960s and early 1970s, but is now a key regeneration area identified by and managed by S4B.



S4B IN BRUNSWICK

S4B is a consortium established by Manchester City Council which includes a number of organisations and experts in development, housing and finance.

S4B is responsible for managing Brunswick and making improvements to the neighbourhood to secure its success for the next 25 years and beyond.

Work in partnership with others to support customers and the community in mitigating the impact of coronavirus

Enhance our digital services and ensure more customers than ever before can access our services online
