How to report it:

Safety first – do not confront fly-tippers.

Do not look for clues in the waste yourself, as there may be harmful items hidden in it.

Keep any notes you make at the time, even scribbled ones, which can be very valuable as evidence.

Take photos if safe to do so.

Any information supplied will be treated in strictest confidence in accordance with the Data Protection Act 1998.

Alternatively you can report it to Manchester City Council **www.manchester.gov.uk** and search 'fly tipping.'

Manchester City Council will investigate incidents, to catch and prosecute offenders. If convicted of flytipping you could be fined up to £50,000 and up to 1 year in prison.
