We've all been shocked and saddened by the tragic incident at Grenfell Tower in London this week. Our thoughts go out to the victims and everyone affected.

S4B would like to reassure all our residents that we have robust fire systems in place but in light of this incident, and similar to many other housing providers, we'll be carrying out a full review of these arrangements.

All residents living in high rise blocks should now have received their fire safety information pack. If you have not received yours, please get in touch.

We will also be writing to all residents about fire safety.

#### In June, quarter one 2017/18 invoices will be issued to right-tobuy leaseholders.

And in September Annual Service charge budgets for 2017/18 will be issued.

Estimated day-to-day costs for 2016/17 are to be compared against actual costs. We will then let leaseholders know if the difference is a shortfall or if a credit adjustment is to be made on this years' account.

If there is a shortfall to pay, leaseholders will be invoiced in December. All customers who are in arrears will be contacted before the end of June but it's never too late to get your account in order.

Contact S4B to make an arrangement to clear your arrears today. This includes ground rent for those customers who only pay that.

UC Universal Credit

From October, Universal Credit (UC) will become more digital for Brunswick customers.

This means you will only be able to make a claim, record your job seeking and report any changes in circumstances via an online account.

If you are already in receipt of UC you will be invited, by the DWP, to re-claim using this new digital platform. You must do this within six weeks to ensure you don't lose out on money.

# Brunswick Pantry Opens its Doors

A new alternative to food banks has launched in Brunswick to help residents with their weekly shop.

Located at the Salvation Army on Grosvenor Street and set up by Community Interest Company, Hope is the Key, the pantry charges residents just £2 in exchange for a selection of goods ranging from tinned food to toiletries and run by a group of volunteers from the local area.

Director, Alishia Johnson, 32, said: "Local shops are being shut, costs are going up, and people are struggling. But many people don't want to use food banks, people still want to pay their way, even if it's a small amount." Contour's community investment officer, Steph Hill said: "Volunteers have created a really friendly and relaxed atmosphere at the pantry to support people. It is great to see local partners come together to fill a much needed gap in services which will be a great benefit to our customers and the neighbourhood".

#### Grosvenor Street

All of the twelve new properties for social rent on Grosvenor Street are complete and residents have moved in.

#### Tristam close The demolition of Tristam close is nearly complete.

Work is underway clearing the site where the new tree lined boulevard will be created through the neighbourhood.

Selham walk is also being demolished and on this site new homes will be built for rent in front of Medlock Primary school.

#### Polygon Site The steel framework is now complete and the roof is in place.

Bricklaying has started which will form the external skin. This all-new development will have 18 apartments for social rent, retail facilities and a new S4B housing office. The housing office on Bramwell Drive will then be demolished to make way for even more new homes. Work will be completed by autumn 2017.
