Keeping up to date...

Leaseholders – you will receive your quarter three invoice, along with an invoice for any other outstanding payments for 2015/16, during week commencing Monday 19th December.

Ground Rent for Leaseholders – you will receive your 2017 ground rent invoice, during week commencing Monday 19th December, which you will need to pay in January 2017.

There is a **Rent Free Week** commencing 26th December for anyone up to date with their rent account.

If you are in arrears, you must continue to pay your rent along with any shortfall – you do not get a free week.

Keep warm, keep well

It is important to keep warm in winter – both inside and outdoors as it can help to prevent colds, flu and more serious health problems. Heat your home to at least 18°C (65°F), if you can, and look out for frail neighbours and relatives.

If you start to feel unwell, even if it is just a cough or cold, don't wait until it gets more serious – get down to your local pharmacist. The sooner you get advice the better.

Get help to heat your home

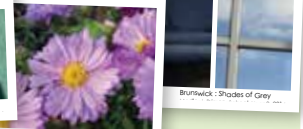
Medlock Primary School

What's the latest...?

Demolitions

2017 will see a number of **demolitions** take place, many of them at the same time. This means some walkways will need to close during this time.

We apologise for any inconvenience this may cause, but this is necessary to create the space needed for the construction of new homes and roads.



Trees

Some tree felling will need to take place this winter outside of the bird nesting and growing season.

We only fell trees that are absolutely necessary, and in line with the timing of our new build and infrastructure programme.

We have already started replacement tree planting on Hartfield Close, and during the course of next year we will be planting over 170 new trees.

We also plan to develop new allotments and an orchard before the end of 2017. In total 721 trees will be planted during all the regeneration.

Tackling Fraud

Manchester City Council is committed to combating fraud and has a duty to protect the public funds it administers.

Shops

There will be **four new shops** on Polygon Street plus a new S4B office with 18 apartments above.

Work on the shops is progressing and the steel framework will be constructed in January 2017.

The City Council has offered the shopkeepers an opportunity to continue to trade until the new Polygon Hub retail units are open for business later next year.



Roads

Clare Street drainage works started in November and due to be finished by March 2017.

The **roads** leading from Beamish Close to the rear of Bramwell Drive up to Kincardine Road, will have the yellow lines and **parking areas** reinstated/refreshed. This area will be incorporated into the new parking scheme to ensure parking is for residents only, and not people going to University or hospitals.

It is the intention to roll out the parking scheme to the rest of the neighbourhood in 2017.

Gated alleyways have been created in Westman Drive, Oregon Close and East Park Close. These will be locked and residents provided with a key in January 2017.



Refurbishments

Artillery Court works are almost complete and residents will have noticed the new bold purple colour render which adds warmth as well as new look to the block. The new balconies are being installed and all internal works will be completed by early 2017.
