Head teacher Miss Herbert said: "Many of the children who attend Medlock live in the area, so this was a great opportunity for them to hear first-hand about the dangers of

playing around building sites.

"This is the second year Ivor has visited the school and everyone really enjoyed the informative but fun session."

The pupils visited the Polygon site which is due for completion later this year, where there will be 18 much-needed flats for rent, a new S4B neighbourhood office and shops also available for rent.

Metal floor and roof structures will have been installed by the end of March, along with ducting for utility services.

Groundworks to create car parking and landscaping to the side of the apartments will also be taking place.

Welfare Reform changes - are you affected?



There are many changes to benefits taking place in 2017 and below we have listed a brief summary.

- There will no longer be automatic entitlement to Housing Benefit (or the housing element of Universal Credit) for under 21 year olds who are unemployed.

The benefit changes, which start in April 2017, also affects:

- Support provided through Child Tax Credits will be limited to 2 children. Any subsequent children born after April 2017 will not be eligible for further support.
- Customers who claim Employment Support Allowance 'work related' will no longer get the weekly £29.05 'top

up' payment, instead they will just get the basic ESA payment amount.

- 18-21 year olds claiming Universal Credit will receive intensive support to find work or training opportunities for the first 6 months of their claim. If they are not working after six months, they will be expected to apply to an apprenticeship, training or skills placement, to continue to receive the benefit.

Top tips

Please help to take care of your property

- Use a shower curtain to stop water splashing on the floor
- Check the shower curtain is long enough. It needs to go inside the bath
- Regularly check bath seals and tiling. If the seals are broken or tiles loose, contact us
- Open windows to reduce condensation
- When bathing, make sure the water doesn't splash onto bare walls and the floor

Home Improvements

If you are thinking of making any home improvements, you must tell us what you are planning and get written permission from S4B before you start any work.

As part of your tenancy agreement you have the right to make improvements and minor alterations to your home and most will be allowed. Introductory Tenants don't have this right until they become Secure Tenants.

S4B would only refuse permissions if the improvements would:

- Reduce the value of the property
- Make it difficult to let the property in the future
- Make the property less safe

You should also be aware that any damage to the property caused by the improvement will be your responsibility to repair, or if the improvement has to be removed to carry out a repair you will be responsible for reinstalling it.

You will require written permission for:

External taps; additional outdoor paving, tarmacking or decking; painting the exterior of your property or boundary; installing water meters; taking down internal walls; changing interior doors; installing sheds, garages, workshops, pigeon lofts, conservatories or house extensions; removing fixtures and fittings e.g. Kitchen cupboards; changes to electrical or gas fittings; laying laminate flooring; removing garden trees.

If you are unsure whether an improvement needs permission, **please contact us on 0300 555 0128 to discuss BEFORE you do the work.** If you carry out work without permission you may need to remove it at your own expense.

Information on how to prevent condensation and mould growth in the home, is now available on the S4B website.

Everyday things like cooking, washing, bathing and even breathing cause moisture, which is released into the air.

Three key ways to reduce condensation are:

- Produce less moisture
- Ventilate your home well
- Insulate and heat your home

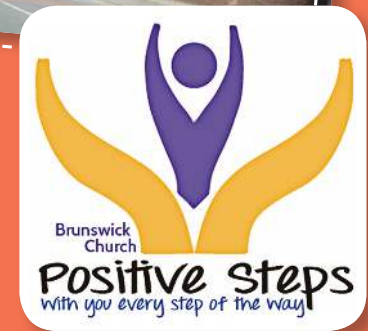
Brunswick Church
