I have no water (or low pressure), what should I do?

If you have no water, or your water pressure has dropped so there's only a trickle coming out of the tap, don't panic there may be a burst pipe which is affecting your water supply. You can check - www.unitedutilities.com/emergencies/current-incidents

If there is nothing listed for your area, please call United Utilities on **0345 672 3723** (24-hours-a-day) or live chat if this service is available (9am-7pm, Monday-Friday).

If you are an S4B tenant and it is not a water supply issue from United Utilities please call **0300 555 0128, Option 2**, 24 hours a day. We'll then make emergency arrangements for someone to attend.

Did you know, you can report a repair online?

Visit the S4B website homepage, the easy to follow diagram allows you to identify exactly where and what the problem is.

You can report the problem as soon as you know about it, no waiting for the office to open. You can even select your preferred appointment. Or send an email to **repairs@S4Bmanchester.co.uk**

Nitrous Oxide

A colourless gas that people inhale, usually via a balloon. Also called Noz/Nox.

THE RISKS

Physical health risks

It is very dangerous to inhale nitrous oxide directly from the canister, and doing it in an enclosed space is also very dangerous. If you take too much nitrous oxide you risk falling unconscious and/or suffocating from the lack of oxygen. People have died this way.

Other risks include:

Dizziness, which might make you act carelessly or dangerously.

Heavy regular use of nitrous oxide can lead to a deficiency of vitamin B12 and to a form of anaemia. Severe B12 deficiency can lead to serious nerve damage, causing tingling and numbness in the fingers and toes. This can be very painful and make walking difficult.

Regular use can stop you forming white blood cells properly.

THE LAW Class: Psychoactive Substances

This is a psychoactive drug and is covered by the 2016 Psychoactive Substances Act, which means it's illegal to give away or sell.

Supply and production can get you up to 7 years in prison, an unlimited fine or both.

Like drink-driving, driving when high is dangerous and illegal. If you're caught driving under the influence, you may receive a heavy fine, driving ban, or prison sentence.

If the police catch people supplying illegal drugs in a home, club, bar or hostel, they can potentially prosecute the landlord, club owner or any other person concerned in the management of the premises.

Additional law details

As of 2016, nitrous oxide is covered by the Psychoactive Substances Act and is illegal to supply for its psychoactive effect.

LOOPER initiative brightens up one of Manchester's most congested areas

S4B has announced the completion of a mural, planters and banners on the busy Brunswick Street.

The work is part of the international LOOPER research project, in collaboration with the University of Manchester and Manchester City Council, to make improvements to one of the city's most congested areas.

LOOPER is working with communities in Brussels and Verona as well as Manchester, to design and implement improvements to public spaces that address traffic congestion, safety, air quality and green spaces.

Spanning 24 meters, the mural boasts bold colours and eye-catching images of the innercity wildlife. It is on the hoardings of the new

together citizens, stakeholders and policy-makers'. It is hoped the mural will cause drivers to slow as they go past.

LOOPER has also temporarily introduced a 20mph zone for cars on Brunswick Street.

Qubek, the artist behind the mural, is one of Manchester's most beloved street artists, whose work often focuses on animals, and bees in particular. For his most recent masterpiece, he found inspiration in the drawings of local children and combined this with his own iconic spray-paint style.

The local community also selected photographs of Brunswick to be displayed in a row of banners down the street. Residents were given hanging baskets to display, and the young people's art skills were once again put to the test, as their work will feature in two 'Welcome to Brunswick' signs.

S4B resident Martin Toal lives in a high rise flat

just off Brunswick Street and has been involved in the project's steering group and delivery.

"I'm pleased to find a group that sought and listened to local concerns and made a difference in my neighbourhood, and glad for the multi-



agency approach to problem solving," he said.

"Officials got together with local people to look for a way forward. I'm happy to be involved with something dynamic where I can make a contribution."

With another year to go, the project's next steps s' will be to evaluate the impacts of the changes that



have been made, especially from the point of view of residents, and further improve them. By the time it ends, LOOPER will develop recommendations concerning what works at the neighbourhood level and how decisions about neighbourhoods can better involve the residents.

Please remember to bring in you bin as soon as possible after it has been emptied to prevent pavements and walkways from being obstructed.
