Collection of annual sum

The annual sum that you pay is a yearly payment based on the size of your home. This is set out in your lease/covenant agreement and is charged annually in January. The charge is made because your property is built on Council land and not for services.

You can pay your annual sum via Direct Debit.

- Owners must not leave rubbish in open areas or common parts. Please use recycling and bins provided on collection day. To find out your day visit http://www.manchester.gov.uk/bincollections
- Owners must not make any external alterations or additions to the property
- Owners must not use the property for any trade business, manufacture or noisy or illegal purpose
- No animals or reptiles to be kept without permission of the landlord
- No loud music or noise between 11pm and 8 am
- Suitable window dressing should be used and fitted
- The garden areas need to be kept in a neat and tidy condition plus clear of rubbish
- The property must be insured
- No 'For Sale' boards are to be erected at the property
- Not to assign or underlet part of the property
- To take responsibility for their visitors and friends' behaviour on the estate
- To know where their children and teenagers are and to take responsibility for their behaviour
