What to do with your Bulky Waste

Before you arrange collection for an unwanted item please consider if others could reuse it.

Charities will collect donated items for free:

- British Heart Foundation
- The Mustard Tree
- St Ann's Hospice Ardwick Furniture Shop
- Tree of Life Centre, Wythenshawe
- Age UK shops

Renew shops

You can donate good quality items in useable condition to be sold at Recycle for Greater Manchester's Renew Shops, including:

- Homeware and furniture
- Garden furniture
- Toys
- Sports equipment
- Books

If it cannot be reused, Manchester City Council offers one free collection per household, up to 3 items every year between 1 April and 31 March. If there are more than 3 items there will be an additional charge of ± 27 .

Do not dispose of any electricals in any of your bins. Anything with a plug, battery or cable must be recycled separately. Take them to a recycling centre/tip or a local recycling point.

Think before you flush!

It's a shocking number, but did you know that around 1,000 homes and 6,000 gardens are affected by flooding each year? That's just in the North West.

Millions of pounds are spent on cleaning drains and sewers right across the UK because of items that shouldn't be in them. Wet wipes, cotton wool, nappies, cotton buds and dental floss are just some of the culprits.

As much as we live in a 'disposable age', it's vital that you think before you flush.

Things like wipes and nappies don't just disappear down the u-bend and dissolve - they clump together and cause havoc in the sewers. All too often we see the misery caused to people when blocked sewers have caused their homes and gardens to flood.

On top of that, many of these items end up in our rivers and on our beaches, which has farreaching impacts on nature and the environment.

It may take a little getting used to, but thinking about what you flush each time will have a fantastic ripple effect - pardon the pun! Put a bin in the bathroom so nobody's tempted to flush.

- Please DO NOT park on any pavement in the Brunswick area.


Keep pavements clear for pedestrian access, especially for those with children and elderly people plus people with prams and wheelchairs for example.
