

Brunswick reaches 9 year milestone!

Transformation of the Brunswick neighbourhood in Manchester is now nine years into its 25-year masterplan.

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As 2023 unfolds, the building element of the project will be coming to an end, but S4B isn't just about bricks and mortar. As well as providing new homes, the area has been transformed into a thriving new community with play areas, allotments and an orchard with over 700 trees planted.

S4B has also helped residents who are now over £1m better off after getting financial advice from the team. 250 local people have also been supported into work and 100 into trainee roles. Each year, S4B works closely with local community groups such as Brunswick Tenants and Residents Association (BTARA), Brunswick Church, Chorlton on Medlock Allotment Society and Manchester Young Community Champions (MYCC) to provide many events such as fun days and sports activities especially during the holidays.

We are now preparing to celebrate our achievements as we approach the 10th anniversary.

Rent Increase 2023/24

From April 2023, Manchester City Council is increasing rent for most of our customers by 11.1% for 2023/24.

UC Universal Credit

If you claim Universal Credit, once your rent has changed, you will need to get in contact with the Department for Work & Pensions via their online portal.

It is important that you don't do this until your rent has actually changed to make sure there are no issues with receiving your benefits. If you need help doing this, please get in touch with our Income Team.

If you do not manage your Universal Credit via the online portal, then you will need to contact the DWP by phoning the helpline on **0800 328 5644**.



If you're concerned that you won't be able to make your payments, contact us to find out about how we can help you. If you're having trouble paying your rent, don't ignore the issue.

FIRE SAFETY UPDATE

Following new fire safety legislation introduced on 23rd January 2023, we have reviewed our communication on fire safety for customers.

New posters have been displayed in all our buildings with communal areas such as the high-rise and maisonette blocks. Information packs have been issued to the remaining properties tailored to suit each property type. All packs have now been delivered to customers.

If you live in a property with a communal area, please remember to keep these areas clear at all times. Failure to do so could result in your items being removed and disposed of.

If we place a sticker on your item, please remove the item within the time specified or the item will be disposed of.

e-bike, e-scooter or conversion kit warning!

If you have an e-bike, e-scooter or kits to convert standard bikes and scooters, please visit the S4B website and read the warning document published by London Fire Service Investigation Team in response to a recent rise in fire incidents.

They want to encourage people who use these products to be aware of the risks and highlight the danger of storing them in escape routes in the home, or in communal areas such as hallways in blocks of flats. LIFECYCLE MAINTENANCE WORKS

have now commenced across the neighbourhood. The timing of this work is based on the age of any building components and the date homes were built or refurbished.

So far in the programme, we have carried out improvements and lifecycle works to boilers, Switch2heat meters, roofing works, communal decorating and boundary works, such as new fencing to certain properties in the neighbourhood.

As part of the 2023/24 programme, you will start to see more improvement works taking place in Brunswick, such as roof works, communal painting, fence and boundary works.

Later this year we will be installing a new sprinkler system to the four high rise blocks: two this year and two next. Further details will be provided as soon as it is available.

Please note, we are currently undergoing an energy assessment survey to sample property types which may influence future works, so the programme may be subject to change. We are committed to supporting the Council's zero carbon agenda. We have now completed boiler replacement to the high-rise blocks and have replaced the old boilers with a new boiler system which is far more efficient.

When the old boilers were analysed before renewal they were running at around 70% efficiency depending on flow, return temps and load on the system. The new boilers now run at around 96% efficiency depending on flow, return temps and load on the system. Therefore, reducing carbon emissions considerably.

We will keep you informed throughout the year on progress with the lifecycle programme and the assessment. Those of you who will be having improvement works carried out at your property will be informed directly with details of what is to be done and when.

Further updates will be provided as we know more. If you have any questions or concerns in the meantime, please get in touch.

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As part of our commitment to supporting the Council's zero carbon agenda, we have made the decision to make this the last printed edition of the quarterly newsletter.

Future editions will be available online only. There will be a very limited number of printed copies for those of you who need one, which can be collected from the housing office or Brunswick Village.

Problems with Damp and mould?



Damp and mould can happen in any home. But it is more likely to happen in some homes than in others. Looking out for signs of it happening and reporting it to us quickly where it is found, is really important.

If you notice any damp or mould in your home, please get in touch with us straightaway. For some people, mould can cause or aggravate health issues - so don't delay, contact us immediately.

There are different kinds of Damp and Mould and they can look quite different, so take a look at our visual guide on the website to help you spot anything in your home that needs attention.

Our team is on hand to help with damp and mould and we will respond as quickly as possible to your queries.



How do I report damp and mould?

Damp and mould gets worse if it is left untreated, so if you spot this in your home please let us know as soon as possible.

What causes damp and mould?

There are three different reasons why damp and mould can occur in the home.

These are:

- Rising damp
- Penetration
- Condensation

Our team will treat any incident of Damp and Mould and will work on providing a solution to prevent damp and mould occurring again. In many cases, sorting it out properly will require some sort of work in your home, which we will carry out as quickly as possible.

Every month we arrange joint monthly walkabouts with residents.

Here are the issues Identified during October to December 2022:

Reported Incidents:		
Fly-tipping	39	
Litter/Leaves	18	
Abandoned Bins	26	

All issues identified have been rectified and we will track the pattern of the same problems month-by-month to monitor improvement.

We will also add in more specific issues like alleyways etc as they come to our attention.

We would very much like residents to come along and join us on the inspections.

Your input is important to us. Please get in touch if you would like to get involved.

WANT TO BE A REP FOR YOUR BLOCK?

If you live in a block, either high rise or maisonette and want to become one of our block reps, then we'd love to hear from you.

What would you have to do?

You would accompany S4B colleagues on the monthly block inspection to discuss and agree any issues that need to be actioned. Be part of the team and have your say in keeping Brunswick clean, tidy and the best it can be.
