



FIRE DOORS

There are a number of fire doors in your building, both your own front door and those in communal areas. These are for your safety and are inspected on a routine basis.

COMMUNAL FIRE DOORS

All communal fire doors must remain in good condition to protect people and property.

- A closing device is installed on communal fire doors and must not be disconnected
- Communal Fire Doors held open by electronic devices must not be interfered with.
 - These fire doors will automatically close if the fire alarm is activated
- Fire doors must not be damaged, removed or obstructed in any way
- Fire doors **MUST NOT** be wedged open at any time.

YOUR FRONT DOOR

- Keep your door in good condition, closing automatically, and report any issues to us
- Do not drill or screw anything to the door, including:
 - Doorbells
 - nails for decorations
 - cables
 - handles or
 - door knockers
- Never disconnect your door's self-closing device.
