We're partnering with Housing Perks to give you access to discounts on your everyday shopping at over 100 shops and online stores.

Housing Perks is a free app offering up to a 20% discount at supermarkets, high street shops and online stores like ASDA, B&M, Sainsburys, Morrisons, Primark, Argos, TK Maxx and more.

Simply download the app by searching for 'Housing Perks' or **scanning the QR code** on your mobile or tablet device.



HOW IT WORKS

By using the Housing Perks app, you can choose to either get a direct discount (paying £16 for a £20 voucher for example) or put your discount into a pot which will automatically go towards your rent payments/arrears.

Simply search for and select the brand you would like to get discount for, enter the amount you would like to spend and press pay securely. You can then view the discount voucher in your 'Wallet' within the app and use it in store or online. You can also print it out.

If you'd like to put your discount into a pot, once you've signed up, tap the 'Rent' icon in the menu at the bottom of your screen, then tap 'Rent Contributions' and make sure it is set to 'On'.

HOW TO SIGN UP

- Download the app from the Apple App Store or Google Play Store by searching for 'Housing Perks' on your mobile or tablet device.
- 2. Enter your mobile phone number.
- You will be sent a One Time Passcode (OTP) via text message. Once you have received your OTP, enter it into the app.
- **4.** When asked to choose your housing association, select 'Onward' from the drop-down list.
- 5. Enter your Tenancy Reference Number, which you can find on the rent review information we send to you each February, via your rent account portal on the S4B website or by contacting us.
- 6. Enter your Tenancy Reference Number along with your contact information.
- 7. You're ready to start saving!
